ADMISSION PROCEDURE RULES AND CONDITIONS FOR ADMISSION TO THE BACHELOR'S DEGREE STUDY PROGRAMME CIVIL ENGINEERING FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2025–26

Article 1

Scope of regulation

- 1. These rules regulate the conditions for the academic year 2025–26 for admission to the *bachelor's degree* study programme *CIVIL ENGINEERING* (hereinafter the "study programme") implemented by the Faculty of Civil Engineering (hereinafter the "Faculty") in accordance with Act No 111/1998, on higher education institutions and amending and supplementing other acts (the Higher Education Institutions Act), as amended (hereinafter the "Act"), and the Statute of Brno University of Technology (hereinafter the "Statute").
- 2. The study programme allows *full-time* study.
- This study programme is intended for self-financing students (the fee for studying for a bachelor's degree in a foreign language is EUR 3,000 per academic year).

Article 2

Conditions for admission

- 1. In accordance with Section 48(1) of the Act, the basic condition for admission to a bachelor's degree study programme is the completion of secondary education with a school-leaving examination (Matura).
- 2. The Dean of the Faculty has ruled that applicants shall be accepted to the bachelor's degree study programme *Civil Engineering* without taking an entrance examination, but English level B2 is required.

Article 3

Maximum number of admitted applicants

The maximum number of applicants that can be accepted in the academic year 2025–26 is 48.

Article 4

Deadline for submitting the admission application

Admission applications can be submitted from 2. 9. 2024 to 31. 5. 2025.

Article 5

Submission of admission applications

- 1. The admission procedure is initiated by the delivery of an application to the Faculty within the specified period.
- 2. Admission applications shall be submitted electronically.
- Along with the application, the following documents must be uploaded to the e-application: an original or approved copy of the applicant's secondary school diploma, and confirmation of its recognition.

The applicant must attach the above-mentioned documents to the application (scanned in pdf format); an original or an approved copy of the secondary school diploma and confirmation of its recognition must be delivered during enrolment and will stay filed at the university.

- 4. In accordance with Decision No 5/2024 of the Rector of Brno University of Technology (hereinafter BUT), the fee for acts related to the admission procedure for the academic year 2025–26 shall be:
 - CZK 700 for each application for admission to study at the Faculty submitted when paying in the Czech Republic to the following BUT account: account number 117729823/0300; bank name Československá obchodní banka, a.s.; IBAN CZ560300000000117729823; BIC CEKOCZPP; account name Vysoké učení technické v Brně;
 - EUR 28 for each application for admission to study at the Faculty submitted when paying in any state other than the Czech Republic to the following BUT account: account number 1017476763/0300; bank name Československá obchodní banka, a.s.; IBAN: CZ040300000001017476763; SWIFT (BIC) CEKOCZPP, account name Vysoké učení technické v Brně

The bank details will also be displayed on the BUT website after the online application has been submitted.

- 5. In accordance with Decision No 4/2024 of the Rector of BUT, the fee for acts related to the assessment of foreign education in the admission procedure for the academic year 2025–26 shall be:
 - CZK 750 for each submitted application for assessment of foreign education when paying in the Czech Republic to the following BUT account: account number 117729823/0300; bank name Československá obchodní banka, a.s.; IBAN CZ560300000000117729823; BIC CEKOCZPP; account name Vysoké učení technické v Brně;
 - EUR 30 for each submitted application for assessment of foreign education when paying in any state other than the Czech Republic to the following BUT account: account number 1017476763/0300; bank name Československá obchodní banka, a.s.; IBAN: CZ040300000001017476763; SWIFT (BIC) CEKOCZPP, account name Vysoké učení technické v Rrně

The bank details will also be displayed on the BUT website after the online application has been submitted. If the fee for acts related to the assessment of foreign education is not paid, the Faculty shall not carry out the assessment in accordance with Section 48(4)(d) of the Act. In such a case, the applicant is obliged to demonstrate the completion and characteristics of his/her previous education in accordance with Section 48(4)(a), (b) or (c) of the Act; otherwise, the Faculty shall terminate the admission procedure.

- 6. The fee is paid when it is credited to the aforementioned account. The fee is non-refundable.
- 7. If the application has deficiencies, the Faculty shall invite the applicant to remove them. If the applicant fails to remedy the deficiencies in the application within the prescribed time limit, or fails to pay the fee for acts connected with the admission procedure in the prescribed form, the Faculty shall terminate the admission procedure. The applicant must be informed of this consequence.

Article 6

Admission decision notification

- 1. The decision on admission to study at the Faculty shall be issued within 30 days of verification that all conditions of the admission procedure have been met.
- 2. The decision may be appealed within 30 days of its notification.
- 3. Applicants admitted to study at the Faculty are obliged to appear in person for enrolment within the deadline set by the Faculty see Article 29 of the BUT Statute. Enrolment will take place at individually agreed times at the Faculty's Office of Student Affairs.

Article 7 Final provisions

- 1. The applicant has the right to inspect the file from the date of notification of the decision during the *opening hours of the Office of Student Affairs*. The Faculty may instead provide the applicant with a copy of the file.
- 2. These rules have been approved in accordance with Section 27(1)(e) of the Act by the Academic Senate of the Faculty on 15th May 2024.
